#### System-Wide Improvement Framework

- Sponsors maintain eligibility for rehabilitation assistance while improving levee systems.
- Incorporates "worst first" to optimize risk reduction.
- Incorporates intergovernmental collaboration
- Incorporates time to address both levee safety and environmental and ESA concerns.
- Incorporates regional differences
- Is synchronized with vegetation variance process and vegetation R&D effort
- Two phase process Letter of Intent followed by SWIF



### **Next Steps**

- Widely distribute SWIF policy last quarter CY2011.
- Post draft vegetation variance policy in Federal Register for public comment last quarter CY2011.
- Support future related research in CY2012:
  - ► Conduct science/stakeholder workshops
  - ► Focus on tools to assist in making better decisions about existing vegetation
- Continue supporting regional collaborative efforts, such as in Washington and California
