- 198 Withdrawn*
- 95 Pending Reverifications*
- Project Area Clarified to Enable Grouping (or Splitting Out if Preferred)

UPDATE ON ESA COMPLIANCE

- Programmatic Biological Opinions (BOs) Including Incidental Take Statements are On-Line www.nws.usace.army.mil
- BOs Cover a Range of New and Ongoing Activities (commercial, recreational, research, shellfish restoration)
- Activities Meeting BO Reasonable & Prudent Measures,
 Terms and Conditions May Use Programmatic BOs for ESA
 Coverage
- Specific Project Information Forms (SPIFs) Growers Can Use If They Choose, But Not Required
- For Activities Not Meeting BO Reasonable & Prudent Measures, Terms and Conditions USACE Must Consult on an Individual Basis to Attain ESA Coverage
- BOs Can Cover Aquaculture Activities Beyond NWP48
