When an emergency strikes, Seattle District can hire construction equipment (i.e. dump trucks, bulldozers, excavators, etc) with operator, by the hour. Government personnel supervise and direct the equipment where it is needed. This same process is utilized for non-emergency projects such as O&M and environmental restoration projects.
