

DUNGENESS RIVER, CLALLAM COUNTY, WASHINGTON

CONDITION OF IMPROVEMENT, 30 JUNE 1971 EXISTING PROJECT: The project, authorized by the Chief of Engineers 7 January 1963 under the authority of Section 205, Public Law 858, 80th Congress, as amended, provides for a levee 2.4 miles long on the right bank of Dungeness River, clearing to increase floodway capacity, and six culverts four with flap gates and one with a slide gate. The improvement is just upstream from the village of Dungeness near the river mouth. Progress Of Work: The project was completed in January 1964, and transferred to Clallam County for maintenance. Cost Of Construction: \$392,106, including \$52,040 Corps of Engineers funds and \$340,067 Public Works Acceleration Act funds. Estimated non-Federal costs were \$70,000.
