

HORSESHOE BEND, KENT, WASHINGTON

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The project consists of an earthfill levee along the right bank of the Green River. One existing flapgated culvert was left in place at the time of construction. The levee extends from rivermile (RM) 24.3 upstream to about RM 26.1 (about 10,500 ft.). Project construction by the Corps of Engineers in late 1996 only improved that portion of the Horseshoe Bend levee from RM 24.36 to RM 25 (about 3,300 feet). The rest of the Horseshoe Bend levee system was judged to already offer SPF protection.
