Johnson Creek Access Area



This primitive camping and access area is 11 miles east of Trestle Creek Day Use Area on State Route 200, and 1 mile southwest of the town of Clark Fork, Idaho. The area is currently licensed to the Idaho State Department of Fish and Game. There is a vault toilet but no drinking water. Boat ramps have been refurbished and lengthened. Open year-round. There are no fees for using the area. Camping is limited to three days within any five day period.
