Corps of Engineers Grays Harbor Navigation Operation and Maintenance Long Term Management Strategy Purpose: The persistent loss of sediment from the entrance to Grays Harbor (including North Beach and South Beach) is expected to continue indefinitely. Shoreline erosion in the vicinity of the South Jetty could result in the eventual breaching of the land mass adjacent to the South Jetty. The purpose of this study is to assess the threat of such a breach to the Grays Harbor federal navigation project and to assess and recommend the most appropriate long-term strategy to maintain and protect Grays Harbor navigation project features. To find the most appropriate strategy, the Corps must work together with all interested parties to ensure all relevant issues and factors are considered. The LTMS is divided into general milestones: 1) Document existing conditions; 2) Develop acceptable alternative assessment criteria 3) Develop and assess alternatives; 4) Develop appropriate NEPA documentation 5) Provide recommendations; and 6) Final report.
