

LIGHTNING CREEK CLARK FORK, IDAHO

CONDITION OF IMPROVEMENT, 30 JUNE 1973 EXISTING PROJECT: The project, adopted 17 May 1950, provides for a riprapped levee 4,000 feet long on the left bank of Lightning Creek near its mouth, to prevent diversions of the stream during floods through the town of Clark Fork. Progress Of Work: The project was completed in March 1959 and transferred to the village of Clark Fork for maintenance. Cost Of Construction: \$42,726. Excludes \$2,000 non-Federal costs.
