

OMAK LEVEES, OMAK WASHINGTON (FLOOD CONTROL)

CONDITION OF IMPROVEMENT, 30 SEPTEMBER 1979 EXISTING

PROJECT: The project, adopted 7 June 1977, provides for 6,400 lineal feet of new levee on the east-bank and 7,700 lineal feet of new levee on the west bank of Okanagan River. These levees provide protection against a 100-year event, with 3 feet of freeboard. Progress Of Work: Levee construction and landscaping were completed in October and November 1979, respectively. Contractor landscape maintenance will terminate in November 1980. Cost Of Construction: A levee construction contract was awarded in May 1978 for \$1,150,000, and the mitigation planting and landscaping contract was awarded in September 1978 for \$194,500. Landscape maintenance by the contractor will continue into FY 81. Local cooperation costs are estimated at \$260,000.
