CONDITION OF IMPROVEMENT, 30 SEPTEMBER 1989 EXISTING

PROJECT: The project, authorized in December 1970 under Section 205 of the Flood Control Act of 1965, provides for construction of a reinforced concrete channel in the lower 5,000-foot reach of Placer Creek, with a debris barrier upstream of the concrete channel, to provide flood protection for the city of Wallace. Progress Of Work: Construction began on 22 July 1981 and was completed in 1986. Cost Of Construction: Federal costs of \$5,865,000 and local costs of \$10,000.
