Historic Preservation Law and Section 106 Compliance

This 3-1/2 day seminar emphasizes legal compliance (the Section 106 process) through the use of actual case studies. It addresses legislation and the process to meet the requirements of the law. Course content includes but is not limited to the following: the stewardship role, use of historic properties, communications with related oversight agencies, i.e. State Historic Preservation Officer (SHPO) and the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation. Sponsor for this course is OASN (I&E), Navy Federal Preservation Officer. Target Audience: DOD activity personnel assigned to cultural resource duties to achieve and maintain compliance with the National Historic Preservation Act (NHPA) and other related cultural resource regulations.
