

**PROJECT COMMENTS:** Property was acquired on 27 September 1943 as a precision bombing range. It was retransferred back to the Department of the Interior on 25 November 1955. Aerial photos indicated cratering. There were several clearances of the range area. In 1964 the clearance authorized unrestricted use.

**DESCRIPTION:** Practice Bombs and General Purpose (HE) type bombs.

**COMMENTS:** Although OE will be concentrated around the target, evidence of bombing is almost always found beyond the scoring arcs. OE debris is typically found throughout the entire property and occasionally beyond the property boundaries. Many factors, such as altitude and flight speed, affect targeting accuracy. From studies completed in WWII, 99% of the bombs should be found within 3,000 feet for bombers flying at 25,000 feet or below and at speeds up to 250 mph. The same study implied a 2,000-foot radius should include 95 percent of the bombs under the same conditions. The range is represented as a 3000-foot radius circle with the center at the center of the "bull's-eye".

The Bruneau PBR No. 2 consisted of 2,552.20 acres. The War Department indicated a necessity and on 23 June 1943 and acquired the land from the DOI by PLO 172, dated 27 Sep 1943, for use as a high altitude bombing range. Target center was 30' x 30', lath construction and painted white. Aerial Photos showed crater indicating use if high explosive bombs. The historic presence of 50-cal ammunition indicates the range may have mistakenly been used for strafing, as there were strafing ranges on other properties in the vicinity.

The first Certificate of Clearance was issued 17 Sep 1954 stated "All of this land has been given a careful search and has been cleared of all dangerous and/or explosive materials reasonably possible to detect. It is recommended that the southern half, Section 3, T7S, R4E be restricted to surface use only. All other tracts are recommended for any use for which the land is suited." The second Certificate of Clearance was issued 24 Jul 1964 for the restricted use portion noted in the 17 September 1954 clearance document. The Certificate of Clearance states, "All lands (320 acres more or less), within the Mountain Home PBR # 2 (Bruneau PBR #2), have been thoroughly searched and are cleared of all explosive ordnance and ordnance residue reasonably possible to detect.
