The roof must be designed to withstand a 40# snow load and a 70 miles per hour wind load. The roof also must have 2' of rigid type insulation with an R-value of at least 10. The posts are to be pressure treated 6 X 8s. The trusses must be engineered as well as the entire building. The roof purlins shall be 2 X 8 hemlock/fir on 24' centers. The roof and wall panels will be 29 gauge ribbed and painted steel with all trim material. Available members of the Boneyard Committee at Chief Joseph Project shall select colors for the building. Wall framing will be 2 X 6s on 24' centers with a 2 X 10 pressure treated baseboard. The building shall be enclosed on three sides and orientated per direction of the General Maintenance Foreman. One gable end wall shall be left open for access to the building. There shall be no concrete floor installed during this building erection.
