The project is an intersection improvement on a state route. Two ditch segments which were dug in uplands (600 linear feet) do not exhibit evidence of flowing water. These ditch segments are not considered jurisdictional waters of the US. None of the non-jurisdictional ditches are straightened or channelized natural drainages nor do they meet the three parameters for wetland designation. The remaining roadside ditches within the project area are both connected to tributaries to Upper Stevens Creek and show evidence of flowing water and are considered jurisdictional waters of the US. There are also three jurisdictional wetlands within the project area.
