ADDITIONAL INFORMATION SUPPORTING NJD

Paragraph 1 – Project area contains a single, 2-acre, shallow depressional, isolated wetland located entirely within the property boundary. The entire 2 acres are proposed to be filled. The size of the isolated wetland is approximate and the exact boundaries have not been verified.

Paragraph 2-3 – The isolated wetland is bordered on all sides by uplands and has no connections to streams, ditches, other wetlands, pipes, or upland swales.

Paragraph 4. – Approximately 1.8 acres of jurisdictional wetlands occur onsite. The applicant is revising his application to fill less than 0.5 of an acre of the jurisdictional wetlands.
