During the third through fifth years after planting, 80% survival is required. Individual plants that die must be replaced with a species from the list below or you can suggest other species but the Corps must approve the species before planting commences. At least two trees must be planted in your mitigation area. You must protect your mitigation area—fencing is recommended.
