RE: Modified State of Washington Coastal Zone Management Program Federal Consistency Decisions for the 16 Nationwide Permits in the Final Rule.

Dear Colonel Bullock:

On January 11, 2022, Department of Ecology (Ecology) provided modifications to the programmatic Section 401 Water Quality Certification (WQC) decision for the 16 Nationwide Permits (NWP) finalized January 13, 2021. Based on the WQC decisions, Ecology has also modified our Coastal Zone Management (CZM) federal consistency decisions for these 16 NWPs.

Please be advised that the consistency decisions for the NWPs do not apply to federal activities or development projects that are subject to 15 CFR 930 Subpart C – Consistency for Federal Agency Activities. For those federal activities or development projects, the federal agency is required to send Ecology a federal consistency determination pursuant to the requirements of Subpart C.

Ecology's federal consistency decisions neither replace nor supersede requirements set forth by other local, state, federal, and tribal laws, nor eliminate the need to obtain additional permits, approvals, consultations, or authorizations as required by law before proposed activities may commence.

Attachment – State of Washington Department of Ecology Coastal Zone Management Federal Consistency Decisions for the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers 16 Nationwide Permits finalized January 13, 2021. These federal consistency decisions apply to all NWP permits authorized in Washington by the Seattle District or Portland District Corps for projects or activities within the State's coastal zone.

State of Washington Department of Ecology Coastal Zone Management Program Federal Consistency Decisions for the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers 16 Nationwide Permits in the January 13, 2021 Final Rule Modified January 12, 2022

As the designated Coastal Zone Management agency in the state of Washington, the Department of Ecology (Ecology) issues the following modifications to Coastal Zone Management Program (CZMP) federal consistency decisions for the 16 Nationwide Permits (NWP) finalized January 13, 2021. These Coastal Zone Management (CZM) federal consistency decisions apply to all projects and activities authorized by NWPs in the 15 coastal counties of the State of Washington: Clallam, Grays Harbor, Island, Jefferson, King, Kitsap, Mason, Pacific, Pierce, San Juan, Skagit, Snohomish, Thurston, Wahkiakum, and Whatcom.

NOTE: Ecology's federal consistency decisions for the NWPs do not apply to federal activities or federal development projects that are subject to 15 CFR 930 Subpart C – *Consistency for Federal Agency Activities*. For those federal activities or federal development projects, the federal agency is required to send Ecology a federal consistency determination per the requirements of Subpart C.

For the 16 NWPs identified below, Ecology has developed the following NWP-specific CZM federal consistency decisions and conditions.
