B. Typical year assessment(s): Typical year assessment is not applicable due to the exclusion criteria of the wetland.

C. Additional comments to support AJD: The subject property is approximately 0.50 of an acre of size and is located in the Sumas Creek subbasin of the Sumas River watershed. The site is bounded to the north by West 2nd Street, to the east and west by single family residences, and to the south by an existing shop building. Surrounding properties have been extensively developed for residential and commercial use. Sumas Creek is located east of this site within 600 to 700 LF according to WDFW mapping system. The closest proximity of the stream corridor to the wetland is found northwestward where the stream bend is found an approximate distance of 350 LF.

The wetland is located approximately 30 feet from a roadside ditch that runs east-west along West 2nd Street. Ephemeral flow may occur across intervening uplands during heavy rain events. The roadside ditch flows for 0.13 of a mile east before entering Sumas Creek. The roadside ditch was historically constructed in uplands and conveys ephemeral flow only; it does not meet the definition of an (a)(2) tributary. While in the mapped Sumas/Johnston Creek 100-year flood plain, the wetlands on the site would not be inundated by floodwaters during a typical year. The subject wetland therefore does not meet the definition of an (a)(4) adjacent wetland and is an excluded water under 33 CFR 328.3(b)(1).
